Improved Book Map Plant Lists

The print format of Book Map plant list has been greatly improved and bugs corrected.

New "Art" and "Bed" NPO Codes

New NPO Codes for artwork and bed outlines have been added.

Edit, Draw and Modify Menus Added

Edit, Draw and Modify pull down menus have been added to the AutoCAD window. These mimic the corresponding menus in "regular" AutoCAD.

Enter Reason for Plant Relocation

When remapping a plant, you can now specify whether this is a correction or the plant was actually moved.

***BG-BASE* Updated When Plant Deleted from Map**

When you delete a plant from map, its coordinates are automatically deleted from *BG-BASE*.

Edit Accession Numbers When Converting Field Data

The field data conversion process has been streamlined and takes you from step to step with fewer menu clicks. When viewing conversion errors, you can click a button to go immediately to editing the accession numbers.

Control Area to Generate in Look Up/Zoom to a Plant

You can now control the size of the area within which plants are generated when zooming to a plant.

HTML Option for Plant List Export

When exporting a plant list to accompany a map, you can select the HTML

format and click a button to preview and print the list.

Thumbnail Images in Plant Lists

New fields available for Plant List Formats allow you to display thumbnail images inside the plant lists. These fields are:

Image Thumbnail (for plant)	Displays an image assigned at the Plant level.
Image Thumbnail (for name)	Displays an image assigned at the Name level.

Automatically Make Plants Inactive

A new option allows you to automatically make inactive plants whose *BG-BASE* location has changed since they were last mapped.

Edit and Upload Checknote Phrases

The Field Data menu has new functions for editing checknote phrases and uploading them to Garden Notepad and PropNoter, helping to insure that all devices have the same phrases loaded.

Location Code Can Be Scanned in Garden Notepad (7.3)

When searching by location, the location code can now be typed or scanned in as well as selected from a drop-down list.

Bug Fixes, etc.

As usual, the update contains numbers subtle improvements and bug fixes.
