# How to Assign Multiple Locations and Images to Web-VQF Garden Features

You can assign more than one map location and more than one image to a single Web-VQF Garden Feature. Here's how:

## Assigning More than One Map Location

A single Garden Feature can have a primary location and several secondary locations. All of the locations will be displayed on the map.

### Primary Location

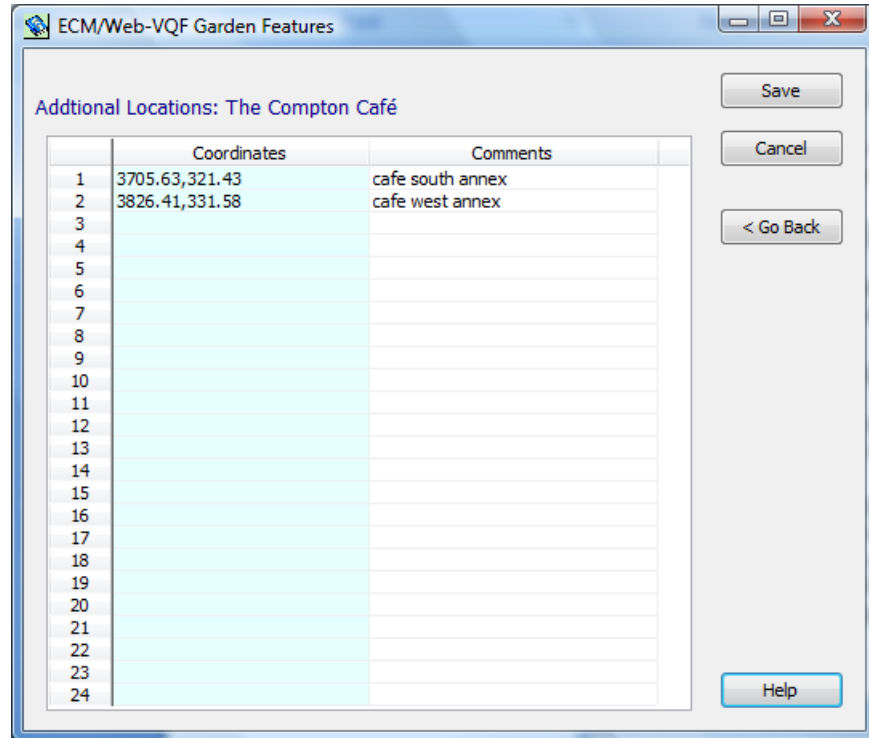
In the Garden Feature data entry window, click "Pick Coords" and click the point on the map corresponding to the primary location. The map coordinates will be filled in.

### Secondary Locations

Click "More Locations."

In the table, click on an empty row. Right-click and select "Pick Coords." Click a point on the map corresponding to an additional location of this Feature. You can enter notes or comments about this location for reference purposes, if desired. Repeat for as many locations as needed. When complete, click "Go Back" to return to the main

window.



## Assigning More than One Image

A single Garden Feature can have a primary image, which appears at the top of the page plus additional images, which appear in a "Gallery" further down the page.

### Primary Image

Click the "Browse Button" , and select an image file to be displayed on-screen with this Feature. Image files are typically JPEG (.JPG) files. The image must be located in a folder named Garden\_Features that is within the main image folder as set up in the ECM and Web-VQF setup window.

### Additional Images

Click "More Images." Or, go to "Tools/Assign Plant and Object Images." The image must be located in a folder named Garden\_Features that is within the main image folder as set up in the ECM and Web-VQF setup window. You may create and use sub-folders within the Garden\_Notepad folder, if you wish.
