How to Add Links to Other Data Sources in Web-VQF

Description

In BG-Map 2017 and later, you can add links to additional sources of information when displaying a plant at the Visitors or Staff Names level. These links will open a new browser tab to display information on the taxon from the outside source.

How to Link to Other Sources

In Web-VQF Setup, on the General tab, check the corresponding buttons to add search buttons to be displayed at the Names Level for these databases:

For Staff Level

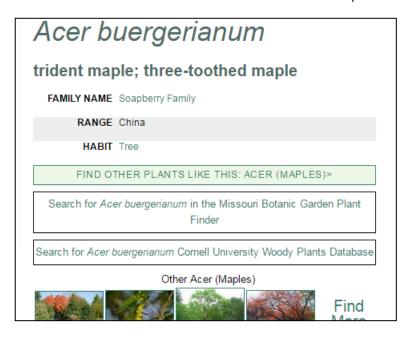
