

# BG-Map Total Station Interface Update Installation Instructions

---

**Note:** Before Installing this software, make certain that you have a backup copy of the file **stations.fil** that contains the latest version of your control point coordinates.

**Note:** If during any installation step, the Device displays the following message, ignore it: "The program you have installed may not display properly because it was designed for a previous version of Windows Mobile software."

**Note:** If you are using this program with GreVid, update GreVid to version 5.4 or later.

## Step 1 - Install NSB Support Files

**Note:** You may skip this step and move on to Step 2 if you have already installed any of the following applications on this mobile device:

- Total Station Interface Version 5.0 or later.**
- Garden Notepad Version 5.0 or later**
- GreVid Version 4.0 or later**
- PropNoter, any version**

Connect the Device to your desktop PC using Microsoft ActiveSync or Windows Vista.

Run the installation program **RuntimeFat.ppc.exe** located in the **NSB Installation Files** folder. Accept all defaults.

Run the installation program **MGCEWin32.exe** located in the **NSB Installation Files** folder. Accept all defaults.

## Step 2 – Install Total Station Interface

**Important:** If, in this step, you see the following message on the Device, answer **No to All**: “Would you like to replace the existing file “\Windows\pvbform2.dll” with this one...”

Connect the Device to your desktop PC using Microsoft ActiveSync or Windows Vista.

If Your Device Runs:	Do This:
Windows Mobile 5.0 or 2003	Run the <b>Install.exe</b> program.
Pocket PC 2002	Run the <b>Install2002.exe</b> program.

Install the program to the Default Installation Location. Choose the “Reinstall” option if prompted.

## Step 3 – Copy the Stations File

**Note:** Perform this step only if you have created a file, **stations.fil** that stores the coordinates of your control points and you have not previously copied it to this mobile device.

Using Windows Explorer, copy the file **stations.fil** to the \Program Files\Total Station Interface folder on the Device.

## Step 4 – Copy the Control Points File

**Note:** Perform this step only if you have created a file, **control.csv** that stores the coordinates and other data about your control points, and you have not previously copied it to this mobile device.

Using Windows Explorer, copy the file **control.csv** to the \Program Files\Total Station Interface folder on the Device.
